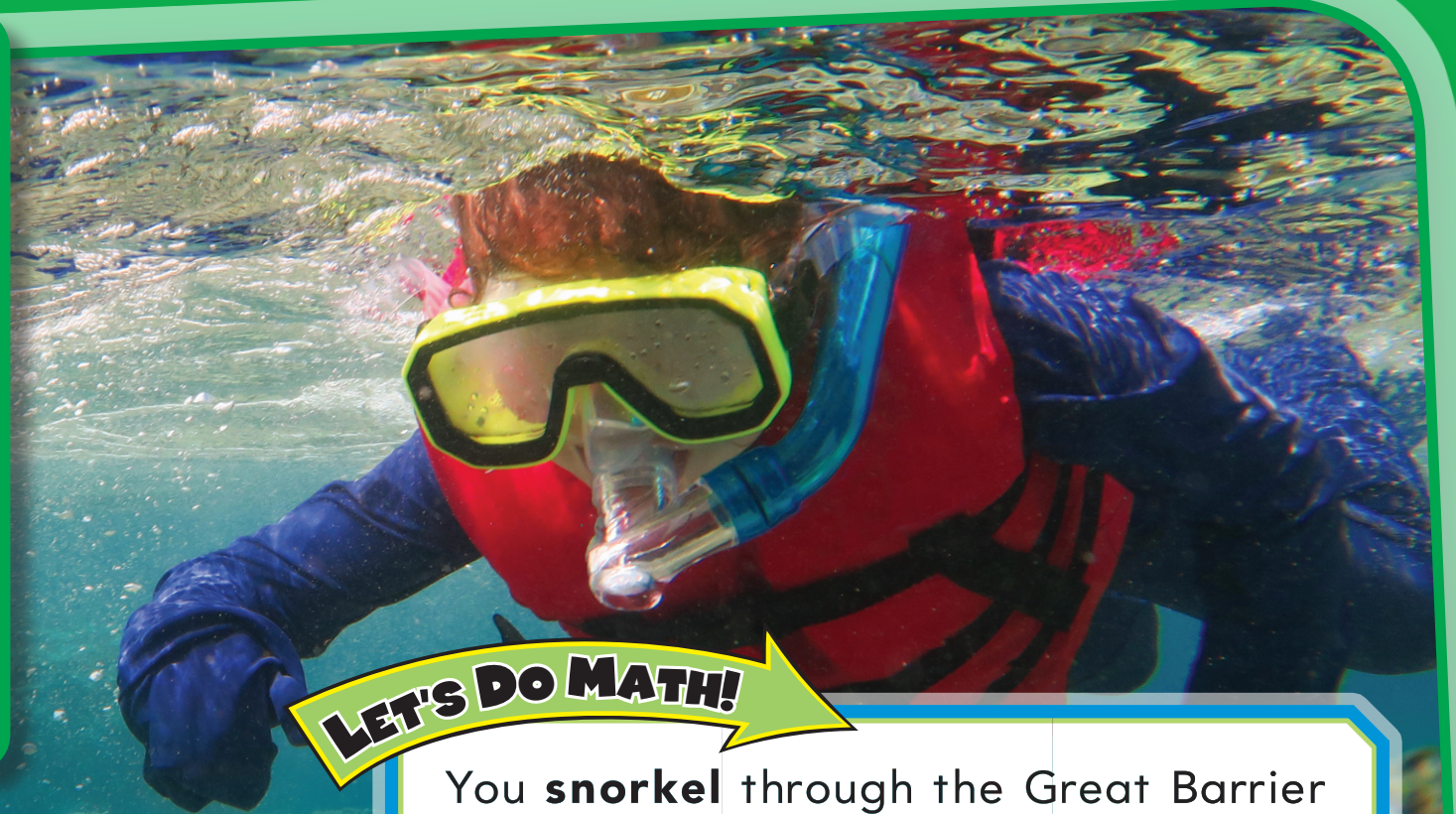


Take Care!

Many people visit the Great Barrier Reef. They must help take care of it. We want the reef to last!



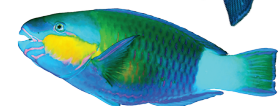
LET'S DO MATH!
